Job Description and Expectations

The DTH editor, editorial page editor, associate editorial page editor and seven editorial writers serve on the editorial board. Board members, including the editorial page editor and associate editorial page editor, are responsible for writing one or two unsigned board editorials each week on a topic agreed upon at the board meeting.

The board meets three times each week — Sunday, Tuesday and Thursday evenings — with meetings usually lasting one or one and a half hours. The time commitment is about six to 10 hours per week.
